Registration: will begin on January 27th for the 2020-2021 school year.

Again this year: For already existing students whose parents have supplied an email address, re-registration will take place on line between February 3-14. More information to come.

Existing students: (no parent e-mail address) Already existing students (except for grade 6) will receive a partially completed form which must be completed, checked for accuracy and signed in blue or black ink. Please return the completed registration form as soon as possible or by Friday February 7th at the latest. If your child will not be returning to PEES, simply check the box at the bottom of the form and return it to the school unsigned.

New students: If you have a child coming to school in the fall for the first time (or know of someone who will be sending their child to school for the first time) please call for an appointment to register (819-843-4847 x 2). Be sure to bring the original of your child's birth certificate (the long form), a proof of citizenship of the eligible parent (original long or short form of the birth certificate or a passport) and a proof of residence (driver's license with address or other gov't document). The child must be five by September 30th for Kindergarten or four by September 30th for Passe Partout.

*** ILLNESS – VERY IMPORTANT ***

Flu season is upon us. If your child shows <u>any</u> signs of illness, please keep him/her at home until well enough to return to both the regular class and <u>outdoor</u> recess.

If your child is sick with a contagion or childhood illness (chicken pox, strep, pinworms, gastro, etc., please advise the office when calling to motivate the absence. Thanks!)

<u>Absences</u> - Very important Notice: Please phone us at school (819-843-4847) by 8 am in the morning if your child will be absent from school. **This is very important and it is for the safety of your child(ren).**

<u>Appropriate Clothing</u>: Please ensure that your child(ren) wears appropriate clothing for the changing weather. Students are also expected to wear appropriate indoor clothing; two pairs of shoes (one for inside and one for outside). Students must NOT wear outside shoes or boots to classrooms. Due to fire regulations, shoes must be worn at all times.

<u>Calendars:</u> If anyone has old calendars with pictures of animals, birds or winter scenes, the kindergarten classes would greatly appreciate receiving them to make crafts. Please send them to the attention of Mme Carole Savard. Thank you!

Sliding: Appropriate winter clothing is required if your child wishes to slide.
