Information:

After-School pickups, during school pickups, change of after school routine or change of person

picking up: Please send a note with your child in the morning to advise the teacher that you will be picking up your child after school or during school for an appointment (please indicate exact time that the student should be at the office). If someone other than the parents are picking up the child(ren), please indicate their name and relationship to the child on the note as well. Phone calls should only be in case of emergency.

<u>Arrival at School:</u> Students should arrive between 7:50-8:00. Classes start at 8:00. It is very important to be on time. When arriving late, it makes it difficult for the child, class and teacher.

<u>Absences:</u> If your child will be absent, parents can advise the teacher in advance in writing, enter the absence on the parent portal directly, sent an email to the school at <u>pees@etsb.qc.ca</u> or call the office and leave a message <u>before</u> 8 am. This is a security measure for the benefit of your children. **Allergies:** Due to severe allergies, we ask that our school community help keep our students safe

by not sending anything containing, or that may contain, nuts or seafood to school in lunches.



<u>Bus delays:</u> Bus delays are now posted on the ETSB website. Click on the purple parent tab and then bus delays. If there are any delays, Transportation will post them there.

<u>Cafeteria:</u> Menus are given to students every two weeks. If for any reason you don't receive one, they are also posted on the PEES website site.

<u>Change of phone numbers or Emergency contacts:</u> If you wish to change a phone number, or emergency contact's name and phone number, in your child's file, please send a note to the school or call the school secretary.

Clothing: Please have your child(ren) dress appropriately for the changing weather.

<u>Cold lunch:</u> Please remember to send utensils when your child is bringing a cold lunch from home. The school cannot supply them. Thank you for your cooperation.

<u>Colour Walk</u> - All students are encouraged to join their group to enjoy the beauty of the Fall colors, to challenge their physical ability and spend a pleasant day with friends and teachers.

Please dress for the weather and don't forget a cold lunch. There will be no hot lunch on this day. **First Communications:** First communications will be available on the parent portal on Monday,

October 14th, 2024. This communication is the first informal report card. If you have any concerns, please contact the teachers directly by sending a note with your child.
