Registration for Grade 6 students to high school:

- If you will be registering your child at Alexander Galt, you will receive more info from Galt.
- If you will be registering your child at any other high school outside of the ETSB, you will need to provide your child's grade 4, 5 and 6 report cards which are available on the Mozaik parent portal. I highly recommend that you save these documents to a personal device before you lose access to them in the summer.
