<u>MAY IS EXAM MONTH</u> - This is a reminder that there are lots of tests going in the month of May including Government exams for grade 6. Please make sure that the students are sleeping and eating well as this can be a stressful period for them. Also, absences can make it difficult for the child to catch-up with these exams so please try to avoid absences when possible.

<u>Grade 6 Grads transferring to another school board</u> – If your child will be transferring to another school board next year, please remember to save all the report cards from the parent portal before you lose access to them. You will need to forward them to their new school. When the June report cards are available, I will email them to parents. You will also need to forward it to the new school.
