Information:

Arrival at School: Students should arrive between 7:50 – 8:00. Classes start at 8:00. It is very important to be on time. When arriving late, it makes it difficult for the child, class and teacher.

Absences: There are 3 ways to report or justify absences; directly on the parent portal, send an email to the teachers or to pees@etsb.qc.ca or call the office before 8 am if your child is going to be late or absent.

After-School pickups, during school pickups, change of after school routine or change of person

picking up: Please send a note with your child in the morning to advise the teacher that you will be picking up your child after school or during school for an appointment (please indicate exact time that the student should be at the office). If someone other than the parents are picking up the child(ren), please indicate their name and relationship to the child on the note as well. Phone calls should only be in case of emergency.

Sickness: Please advise the school if your child contracts any infectious diseases (strep, pink eye, chicken pox, whooping cough, measles, head lice, etc.)

Banque Alimentaire Food Drive: Food Drive (Dec 1 – Dec 16) - We will be collecting food, toiletries, cleaning supplies, etc. to help the “Banque Alimentaire de Magog” who support our local families. Your support is greatly appreciated!

Book Fair: The PPO would like to invite families to visit the Book Fair on November 27th during the Parent/Teacher interview night, and on November 29th from 9:00 to 3:00 during the Craft Fair. There you will have access to wonderful selection of children’s books for all ages. Great for Christmas gifts! Students must be accompanied by a parent to visit the book fair. The more books we sell, the more credits we get from Scholastic to put new books in the classrooms and library.

Students should always be at their stop at least 10 minutes before the expected bus arrival, as estimated bus arrival times could fluctuate (incident on bus, construction, weather or road conditions, absent students make the bus arrive sooner etc.).
