Arrival: Students should arrive between 7:50 and 8:00. It makes it difficult for both students and teachers when students arrive late. If your child will be late or absent, please advise us via the Mozaik Parent Portal, email or calling the office at 819-843-4847 ext. 2.

After school pickups/change of after school routine: If, on any given day, you need to change what your child usually does after school or you wish to pick up your child after school, please send a note to the teacher with your child in the morning. Phone calls are only supposed to be in case of emergency.

Book Fair: The PPO would like to invite families to visit the Book Fair on November 27th during the Parent/Teacher interview night, and on November 29th from 9:00 to 3:00 during the Craft Fair. There you will have access to wonderful selection of children’s books for all ages. Great for Christmas gifts! Students must be accompanied by a parent to visit the book fair. 
